5 facts you should know

1. Teachers continue to use their existing textbooks but replace 2-4 weeks of instruction with the Common Core Exemplar Lesson Plan which is based on the PARCC “**Model Content Framework.**”
2. The Exemplar Lesson Plans are effective *learning* tools for ELA teachers as they create Common Core aligned classrooms. Teachers learn gradually how to do Close Analytic Reading (CAR) of Extended and Short Texts, how to develop Text-Dependent Questions, how to integrate Routine Writing and writing for research into each Nine-Week Term.
3. The Exemplar Lesson Plans include the majority of the grade level Common Core State Standards (CCSS). This procedure is repeated 4 times during the year (each 9 weeks term).
4. Text Selections for Extended Reading and Short Texts are Common Core Exemplar Texts or are of comparable text complexity.
